The link between corruption and terrorism was never more evident than in the events of September 11, 2001. Since the passage of the OECD Anti-Bribery Convention, what has Canada been doing and what is it planning to do to eradicate the scourge of corruption? Richard Lee, Senior Advisor, Financial Institutions and Industry Liaisons, Financial Transactions and Reports Analysis Centre of Canada, will provide an update of FINTRAC and the Proceeds of Crime and Money Laundering Act; representatives of government will address the inclusion of anti-corruption clauses in contracts with their clients and Canada’s role, nationally and internationally, in the anti-corruption movement; Michael Davies, Vice Chair, Transparency International Canada will introduce the “Business Principles for Countering Bribery,” which are being developed by TI in cooperation with the international business community - these Principles seek to give practical effect to recent initiatives, such as the OECD Anti-Bribery Convention, the ICC Rules of Conduct to Combat Extortion and Bribery and the anti-bribery provisions of the OECD Guidelines for Multinationals.
